CONTENDING FOR THE FAITH

Can't Have One Without The Other!

"Student loan debt is now the second-highest consumer debt category behind only mortgage debt - and higher than both credit cards and auto loans. According to Make Lemonade, there are more than 44 million borrowers who collectively owe \$1.5 trillion in student loan debt in the U.S. alone" – Forbes Magazine. There is a relentless quest to acquire knowledge regardless of what it takes. Sadly, however, many are not able to apply the knowledge that they have acquired for various reasons.

Of what benefit though, is knowledge, if all we do is to learn it? This, of

course, was Solomon's experience. In **Eccl. 1:1-18**, he tells that pursuing knowledge is like "chasing after the wind," since knowledge by itself is of no use. While the word of God places great emphasis on the importance of knowledge, it has placed even greater importance on using it. John exhorts us in **I John 3:17-18** "But whoever has this world's goods, and sees his brother in need, and shuts up his heart from him, how does the love

of God abide in him? My little children, let us not love in word or in tongue, but in deed and in truth." James echoes the same sentiment when tells to "But be doers of the word, and not hearers only, deceiving yourselves," James 1:22.

Let us be clear though, the importance of knowledge and acquiring it is one of the foremost teachings of the Bible. The Jews were commanded to teach their children and to take radical steps in doing so (**Deut. 6:5-9**). But the knowledge that we acquire from God's word must be used to guide our actions. In fact, the right actions are products of the right knowledge, and the right knowledge will be the driving force behind the right actions, you just can't have one without the other. Paul expressed great concern for his fellow Jews who were still ignorantly keeping the law of Moses zealously, at a time when it was no longer valid. **Romans 10:2** "For I bear them witness that they have a zeal for God, but not

Ultimately we will be judged by what we have done (**II Corinthians 5:10**). Consequently, let us diligently study God's word for knowledge and obediently living accordingly to His Word.


