

CONTENDING FOR THE FAITH

I Chose To Be A Member of the Church of Christ because... Of Its Divine Origin

With so many churches in existence today, it is quite easy for one to be confused about which is really from God, especially since Paul says that, "there is one body..." **Eph. 4:3** and that the body is the church **Eph. 1:22-23**. It is relatively easy to start a church and give it a name and establish one's own creeds and practices. However, Paul told the Ephesians that **Eph. 1:4** that Christ "...chose us in Him before the foundation of the world..." This means that a body of people were predestined to be saved by God, even before the world was created. This is important because there is the school of thought that Jesus came to set up an earthly kingdom but, because of the opposition and rejection from His fellow Jews, He changed His mind, and set up a spiritual kingdom, the church. This idea is contrary to the clear teachings of God's word.

A remarkable fact about the church, since it was in the mind of God before creation is that its beginning originates with God. Several prophesies had been made regarding the church. John the Baptist and Jesus both told the people to repent for the kingdom of heaven was at hand. Later, we find Jesus promising to build His church in Matt. 16:18. In the Old Testament, Isaiah refers to the church as the "Lord's House", Isa. 2:2-4 and also tells us when this would be, where it would be, who would be part of it, why it would be established, and how. As to when this would happen, Isaiah says it will be in the "latter days" or "last days" (Old KJV). This is referring to the final age before the judgement, which was confirmed by Peter in Acts 2:16-17 who quoted Joel's prophecy in Joel 2:28-32 in explaining the events on the day of Pentecost. As to where, the prophet says, it would take place in "Zion" or "Jerusalem," which is exactly where the disciples where according to Acts 1:4-5. As to who would be part of the "Lord's house," Isaiah said, "...all nations shall flow into it" as opposed to just the Jews. Paul says in Gal. 3:28 that "There is neither Jew nor Greek, there is neither slave nor free, there is neither male nor female; for you are all one in Christ Jesus." As to how, Isaiah again says, "He will teach us of His ways." No one can become a member of the church today unless he has been taught of God. Jesus tells us in John 6:45 "It is written in the prophets, 'And they shall all be taught by God.' Therefore everyone who has heard and learned from the Father comes to Me." As to why? The Lord is not willing that any man should perish (II Pet. 3:9), which requires men to "walk in His ways" (Isa. 2:3). He, therefore, established the church to which He adds daily those who are being saved (Acts 2:47).

Since the Church of Christ can find its origin back in these prophesies and fulfillments, it therefore underscores the point that it is not just another religious body claiming to be of God, but the scriptural and doctrinal evidence prove this to be true. Based on the biblical texts available to us, any church that comes either before or after Acts 2, is either too early or too late!
