CONTENDING FOR THE FAITH

Why I Chose to Remain a Member of the Church of Christ

For the next several weeks, I will be presenting several reasons why I made the decision, thirty years ago, to remain a member of the Church of Christ. These reasons serve to fortify my faith in the doctrines that the church believes and teaches. My choices or mean nothing if they are made without any scriptural basis. Therefore, it is my prayer and hope that in sharing this information, you too can experience a strengthening of your faith in God, and a deeper appreciation for this unique institution.

What were your reasons for becoming a member? I ask because many question the validity of their faith. Some grew up in the church and felt a need to carry on the "family tradition" by becoming a member. Some became members because their spouses already were. Others, because it was the closest church to their home or perhaps was the only church in their little community.

However, if you don't have solid and scriptural reasons why you chose to be a member of the church, you will be like children "...tossed to and fro and carried about with every wind of doctrine, by the trickery of men, in the cunning craftiness of deceitful plotting," (Eph. 4:14). Also, people have a right to question us about our faith, since it a great opportunity to share that faith with them. Peter says that we must "...always be ready to give a defense to

everyone who asks you a reason for the hope that is in you, with meekness and fear;" (I Pet. **3:15).** With so many today being duped by false teachers, it becomes an absolute necessity to make sure that our faith and reasons are aligned with the inspired word of God. Mere sentimental attachment to the church is insufficient.

The doctrine of Christ, which is the doctrine of the Church, is what draws us to Him, and it is also what causes us to want to remain a part of His body. In light of this, the Hebrew writer says, "Therefore we must give the more earnest heed to the things we have heard, lest we drift away" (Heb. 2:1). Knowing what the church believes and teaches are essential for our spiritual endurance and helps to create a balance in our commitment, which is a zeal that is coupled with knowledge (Rom. 10:1-3).

With so many religious groups in the United States alone, do you find anything distinct and unique about the church of Christ? For the next few weeks, as I share my own scripturally based reasons for choosing the Church of Christ, I hope that your faith and conviction may also be strengthened, so that you can confidently defend your decision when the time comes.
