CONTENDING FOR THE FAITH

"This Is the Friendliest Church"

The Lord was no "respecter of persons." He talked with those He met, showing them a glimpse of God's love. He helped those in positions of power, whether it was a royal official, a Jewish synagogue ruler, or a Roman centurion. He also cared about those of little status, whether children, the poor, or those with physical infirmities. Jesus made people feel valuable whatever their situation in life was---because, indeed, they were!

Ask his disciples, we are called to this same type of friendliness. There is no place for cliques in the Kingdom. Jesus had his closest circle of friends: Peter, James, and John. He was also close to the rest of the twelve. At the same time, He never had too many friends or personal contacts. He even befriended people when His closest friends and other followers discouraged him (Matt. 19:13-15; 20:29-34). We must ask ourselves the question, "Do I greet people like Jesus did?"

As a college freshman, I felt alone walking in a crowd of people at a large university of 25,000 students. There was always a distance when only a few would smile or say, "Hello." I felt like a number rather than a person. I experienced the expression "the loneliness place for someone that is alone is in a crowd."

However, in the Church of Christ, this is the last thing we should expect. We should be a people of warmth closeness and friendliness. We should not walk past others without making them feel welcome whether members or visitors. We should welcome and visit with those who sit near us. The command to "greet" other Christians is used throughout the New Testament letters (Rom.16:3-16). Jesus would rather have people leave our assembly and say, "That is the friendliest church."
