

## **CONTENDING FOR THE FAITH**

## The Faith for these Times!

Isn't it amazing how some of the greatest statements of faith in the Bible were made in the worst circumstances? Maybe that is because difficult situations test the courage and determination of our faith.

That was the case for Jeremiah. In the book of Lamentations, the prophet poured out his sorrow over the destruction of Jerusalem, the holy city of God. As Jeremiah witnessed the destruction of the city, the temple, and the people of God, he was horrified. Nevertheless, the prophet believed in God's promises concerning the restoration of Jerusalem. Despite the great heaps of rubble, Jeremiah could confidently write, "Through the LORD'S mercies we are not consumed, Because His compassions fail not. They are new every morning; Great is Your faithfulness. "The LORD is my portion," says my soul, "Therefore I hope in Him!" The LORD is good to those who wait for Him, To the soul who seeks Him. It is good that one should hope and wait quietly for the salvation of the LORD" (Lamentations 3:22-26).

How about Job who experienced tragedy beyond words when he lost all his children and his servants and his entire wealth according to Job 1. What was his response? "Naked I came from my mother's womb, And naked shall I return there. The LORD gave, and the LORD has taken away; Blessed be the name of the LORD" (Job 1:21). The theologian, Adam Clarke puts it like this: "I had no earthly possessions when I came into the world; I cannot have less going out of it. What I have the Lord gave: as it was his free gift, he has a right to resume it when he pleases; and I owe him gratitude for the time he has permitted me to enjoy this gift." Job later said with great confidence and hope, "I know that my redeemer lives and that in the end, he will stand on the earth (Job 19:25).
