



CONTENDING FOR THE FAITH

"What About Him?"

here they were on the shore of the sea of Galilee. Jesus, Peter, and John. After Jesus and his disciples had finished eating a bread and fish breakfast, Jesus and Peter went for a walk. John, the disciple whom Jesus loved, was following them, probably wanting to listen to their conversation. The Lord had forgiven Peter for his denial and had been talking to him about his future role in the Kingdom. Then Jesus got into the hard part; He told Peter about his ultimate martyrdom. At this point, Peter turned and saw John. He then asked the Lord a familiar question: "What about him?" John 21:21

This question is often heard today in disputes among siblings. It is a cry for equality and justice. A younger child asks why the older child does not have to go to bed at the same time: "What about him?" An older child asks why the younger does not have to perform the same difficult chores: "What about her?" Adults also ask the same question. For some reason, we expect uniform equality and fairness in life. However, God gives us all different gifts, opportunities, and challenges.

It is tempting for us to have the wrong focus: We compare ourselves to others instead of Jesus. We apply sermons to others instead of ourselves. Sometimes we pick at the specks in the eyes of others, but we are blinded by our own planks. Jesus calls us to examine our own commitment. He answered Peter, "If I wanted him (John) to remain alive until I return, what is that to you? You must follow me" John 21:22.
