

# **CONTENDING FOR THE FAITH**

## White WITH Snow or White AS Snow!

Chicago, this time of year, is either very cold or very cold with snow. In fact, many are "dreaming of a white Christmas" as the song says since it is also the time of year when nature puts on a spectacular show, when just about everything looks immaculately white after our first accumulating snow.

However, being white WITH snow may be great to look at, but I am thankful that though our sins are as scarlet and red as crimson, we can become white AS snow. The inspired record of the prophet Isaiah says, "Come now, and let us reason together," Says the Lord, "Though your sins are like scarlet, they shall be as white as snow; Though they are red like crimson, they shall be as wool" Isaiah 1:18. This was not a

call for negotiation for God does not negotiate where sin is concerned (Isa. 59:1-2; Luke 13:5). Instead, the people were being called upon to be convinced in their minds that their Creator was right they were wrong! God refused to even hear their prayers because their "hands were full **blood**" (v. 15). They had no compassion for the most vulnerable of their community,

the widows and the fatherless, and said nothing to the oppressors of the poor. Consequently, God says, "When you spread out your hands, I will hide My eyes from you; Even though you make many prayers, I will not hear. Your hands are full of blood." (v. 15).

God then throws out a lifeline to these sinful people who are destined for eternal punishment. He described their sin as being like "scarlet" and "crimson" which are shades of red. This can be compared to cloth that has been dyed or stained in red. However, through His compassion, mercy and love, they can become spiritually "white as snow" if they are willing to repent. This concept is prophetic in that it would become the cornerstone of the New Covenant established by Christ. The Lord prophesied centuries before in Jeremiah 31:31, 34 that under this New Covenant He, "will forgive their iniquity, and their sin I will remember no more." The idea of being "white as snow" suggest not partial but complete forgiveness. Because sin forgiven means to be erased from memory.

While a layer of snow on the ground can make outside look spectacular, nothing compares to our lives, having been soiled by sin, becoming white AS snow by the shed blood of our Savior!
