

or some folks, the Christmas season is their favorite time of the year---the beauty of strings of lights and decorations, the crispness of the cold winter air, and maybe the pureness of fresh snow. It is a time of generosity when some of the Scrooges of the world find it in their hearts to think of others.

Some people herald Christmas as the day of Jesus's birth. Their celebration is as though they are saying, happy birthday Jesus. Scripture lends no support to this idea. Luke records Jesus's birth in this way after Joseph and Mary reached Bethlehem: "While they were there,

the time came for the baby to be born, and she gave birth to her firstborn, a son. She From time to time, we may hear people wrapped him in cloths and placed him in a manger" (Luke 2:6-7). The Bible gives neither a specific date for Jesus's birth nor an Christmas." However, we should not indication of God's desire for us to celebrate it (in contrast to remembering Jesus' death each week in the Lord's Supper). 
