

The Uncertainties of Life

Tt was R. E. Winsett who penned the song *Jesus is Coming Soon*, a line of which reads "Troublesome times are here, filling men's hearts with fear...". Though written in 1942, those words continue to be ever so relevant today. We fear uncertainties! We like to prepare ourselves well in advance for life's events. The recent earthquakes that took well over 25,000 lives in Turkey and Syria underscore the reason why we dread uncertainties. However, no meteorological devices can remove the uncertainties of natural disasters from our lives, consequently, fear will always be a dominant part of our lives. Is it any wonder why Paul told the

Corinthians that "If in this life only we have hope we are of all men most miserable" (1 Cor. 15:19).

As followers of Jesus, we can have peace amid uncertainties because we have the assurance that our Heavenly Father loves and cares for our needs (Phil. 4:6-7). "The peace which surpasses all understanding," as Paul wrote, "will guard your hearts and minds through Christ Jesus" To say that the peace of God surpasses all understanding means

that we cannot properly comprehend it, but we can experience it as He guards our hearts and minds. Our Lord encouraged His disciples by encouraging them with the same thought in John 14:27 "Peace I leave with you; my peace I give you. I do not give to you as the world gives. Do not let your hearts be troubled and do not be afraid.'

Our peace comes from the confidence that the Lord loves us, and that He is in control. We may not know what tomorrow holds, but we certainly know who holds tomorrow. Our Father alone provides the comfort that settles our nerves, fills our minds with hope, and allows us to relax even in the midst of changes and challenges. We must live our lives purposefully and not burden ourselves with worry and fear but keep close to our bosoms the words of David, "Even though I walk through the valley of the shadow of them, I will fear no evil, for thou are with me, thy rod and thy staff they comfort me" Psa. 23:4. The prophet Isaiah sums it up well for us when he said, "You (God), will keep him in perfect peace, whose mind is stayed on You because he trusts in You.'
