

eginning in the mid 80's, I was at "church" so much, I joked about having my mail forwarded there. Sunday morning and evening Bible study and services, Wednesday evening Bible class, and chorus rehearsals on Friday evenings. Annette and I were teachers and counselors for our children and youth. There were ALWAYS special events and programs on the weekends, many of them out of town. Those were wonderful times that we often recall and remember with great joy.

As Y2K rolled in, I was working full-time and completing my undergraduate studies. I

was working in the church, being an only-child caretaker for my parents, and legal guardian for my aunt. Jonathan was diagnosed with moderate autism in 1999 and began to indicate more severe behaviors. I was losing it, and didn't pay attention to my mental health. Everything went dark, and I was diagnosed with major depression. Attending church became difficult, then impossible. I felt absent without leave.

I began to appreciate all those years of being at church all the time, of attending worship and studying and singing and praying and serving the Lord. In my ocean of despair, God kept me afloat, and He did not let me drown.

approached God, shouting to ask for his patience. "God, I"M NOT LETTING YOU GO! If

you hold on to me, and keep me close, I promise to serve you again when the Light returns to my life!" I began to appreciate all those years of being at church all the time, of attending worship and studying and singing and praying and serving the Lord. In my ocean of despair, God kept me afloat, and He did not let me drown.

Due to my current physical health, I struggle with my church attendance. However, I am determined to serve the Lord to the best of my ability! I will NOT be "Absent With Out the Lord!" Cause GOD IS GOOD! There will be challenges, and there may be darkness. But: "The Lord is my Light and my salvation; Whom shall I fear? The Lord is the STRENGTH of my life; Of whom shall I be afraid?" (Psalm 27:1) Praise God, and be blessed!
