

CONTENDING FOR THE FAITH

Reach Out and Touch: Multimodal Approaches to Edification

As Christians, we have the responsibility to edify one another. However, we often feel ill-equipped with the words to lift up our brothers and sisters in Christ. This article highlights the multimodal approaches of lifting up and edifying.

One method we often focus our energies on is sharing scripture. When we see a brother or sister in need of encouragement, we reach for the Bible and search for a scripture that will edify. We may text an individual 1 Corinthians 10:13. Sometimes not even the full text, just the book, chapter, and verse. This speaks to the common language of Chris-

tians, a topic to be discussed in a later article. Through scripture, we give comfort through a universal text that is universally known and familiar.

The same comfort, however, can be found in songs. The same message we find in 1 Corinthians 10:13 can be found in songs that we sing in worship service. This mode of edification uses the words and talents of artists to encourage and uplift. This is not to say that songs and poetry

can be substituted for scripture, but to illustrate that in some moments a song may better fit our particular situations. I've witnessed a church family surround a sister in turmoil and sing songs of encouragement.

By the last song each and every participant was uplifted along with the sister! We find in Ephesians 5:19 where Paul encourages us to speak to each other using "psalms, hymns, and spiritual songs." One brother may text a scripture, while another brother may text a line from "Hold to God's Unchanging Hand" (Wilson and Eiland, 1933). And if you're not familiar with that song, Tupac's "Keep Ya Head Up" is one of my favorites!

Another way still, is to sit and pray with a brother or sister. We could also just sit and listen to one another. We don't necessarily need someone to solve our problems, but just someone to listen.
