

Blissless Ignorance

Looking at the state of the world and our communities, we can't help but become saddened and enraged. With all the senseless killings and the endless robberies in our communities we feel that there is no hope. We ask ourselves, "how could someone do something like that?" or "how can someone be so evil?". As we strive to make sense of it all, we begin to question God's

infinite wisdom. We wonder if God even cares.

Be reminded that God loves the world so much that He gave His Son (John 3:16) and that His wisdom far exceeds our senses (Isaiah 55:9). The error, therefore, lies in **growing weary in** the ignorance of man. In Jeremiah 4:22 we see Jeremiah. like us. mourn the state of his people. He acknowledges that their evil doing and foolishness is a direct result of

their ignorance of God. Jeremiah records, "They are wise to do evil, But to do good they have no knowledge" (NKJV). Not only are these people ignorant of God, they are also ignorant of how to do good. The phrase "ignorance is bliss" couldn't be further from the truth.

While this scripture refers to the children of Israel, there is a correlation to our communities. We are living among people who are ignorant of God and ignorant of good. This ignorance leads to the evil and foolishness that we encounter, whether face to face or digitally. This ignorance, however, cannot be excused. While God once overlooked it, he now requires everyone to turn from ignorance and know Him (Acts 17:30; 2 Peter 3:9; 1 Timothy 2:4). Let us continue to have faith in the wisdom of our God. Let us continue to be a light in this dark world, not growing weary in doing good (Galatians 6:9).
