


WELCOME VISITING FRIENDS

CONTENDING FOR THE FAITH

Keeping It Real

I am often asked the question, "Who is your favorite person in the Bible?". Of course, this question is quickly followed by "and you can't say Jesus". For many years my favorite person in the Bible has been and still is the apostle, Peter. Is it because he preached the first gospel sermon? Is it because after he preached about three thousand souls were saved? No. Simply put, Peter kept it real.

We know that Peter, after "cussing" people out, denied Jesus three times (Matthew 26:69-75). We are familiar with Paul confronting Peter about some of his racist or partial tendencies and how they caused division (Galatians 2:11-13). Most notably, when all the others were sitting quietly Peter was known for his big mouth or getting himself into situations (Matthew 14:28-30; 16:21-22; 17:1-6; 26:33-35). Despite this, I love that Peter acknowledged that he was imperfect. By being honest with

himself and owning his flaws, Peter was in a better position to be taught and forgiven. In John chapter 13, Jesus is washing the disciples' feet. When He got to Peter, Peter refused to allow Jesus to wash his feet for he knew that he was unworthy. Peter tells Jesus, "You will never wash my feet" (verse 8). Here, we see Peter speaking when all the others kept quiet. But in this moment of honesty, Jesus was able to teach Peter, and us through Peter, that if we do not receive the cleansing that Jesus offers, we will have no part with Him. Through being washed by Jesus, Peter was in communion with Him. By being washed in Christ's blood, we have communion with Christ (John 13:8, Acts 2:38). But this cannot be done without repentance. Peter took back his statement and told Jesus, "Lord, not my feet only, but also my hands and my head" (John 13:9). Shouldn't we ask Jesus to do the same?

The apostle Peter confessed his faults and grew closer to Jesus as a result. He didn't hide behind his pride or position. He left himself completely exposed so that his sins may be completely disposed! Let us aim to be like Peter (in some regards) and confess our faults. Let us not waste time defending our positions, but instead spend time learning what Christ expects from us. Let us be real with ourselves and own up to our faults knowing that Jesus is ready and willing to forgive (1 John 1:9). Whether we call him "Big Mouth Peter" or "Sit Down Somewhere Peter", his life and candor encourage us to keep it real for the sake of our souls.
