

LEFTOVERS

he origin of the American holiday, Thanksgiving, is steeped in religion and faith. Seeking to create a day of "thanksgiving and prayer" President Washington, and later President Lincoln, proclaimed Thanksgiving to be celebrated in America annually (Smithsonian). One American tradition that is almost synonymous with Thanksgiving is leftovers. If you don't have mounds of leftovers after, did you really celebrate Thanksgiving? Every family has that one auntie that packs up "leftovers" before she even creates her plate for the actual day of Thanksgiving.

Leftovers are the physical manifestation of abundance. Throughout scriptures we read about the blessings of God and how He gives us more than we need, resulting in leftovers. In Malachi 3:10. God promises to pour out so many blessings, that

we won't have room for them all. Jesus came so that we not only will have an abundant life, but a more abundant life.
