



CONTENDING FOR THE FAITH

STEEL TOE BOOTS

Often after delivering a sermon, I am told that I "stepped on some toes", a common phrase meaning that some feelings were hurt or that the words I had said may have affected someone listening. In Act 2:37, we see where Peter "stepped on some toes" while delivering the first gospel sermon. While I don't delight in the pain of others, it would be disingenuous of me to claim that I don't step on toes intentionally. After all, the three thousand souls that were saved only recognized their sad condition after Peter's words "cut them to the heart" (Acts 2:37 NIV). I can't help but believe that the greatest compliment you can give a preacher or public speaker is that they "stepped on some toes". This lets the speaker know that the message was compelling and effective. However, there are times that no matter how compelling a message is, some hearts refuse to be pierced and some toes never feel the impact. Some people are wearing steel toe boots.

In 1 Timothy 4:1-3, Paul warns Timothy that there will be false prophets who will spread lies and not feel bad about it. He refers to the conscience of those people as "seared with a hot iron". In Romans 1:28, Paul speaks of people who are so devoted to a life of sin and unrighteousness that God has given them over to a reprobate mind. If is difficult to reason with a reprobate or depraved mind. It is almost impossible to reason with someone whose conscience is seared with a hot

iron. These people have developed a "steel toe boot mentality" where they cannot be pierced to the heart or moved to repentance. These individuals refuse to be taught righteousness and refuse to obey God's word. No matter how many times you plead with them to repent, no matter how many scriptures you share with them, they refuse to repent or even feel remorse.

We must be careful to never end up in this sad condition. Repentance cannot take place with a steel toe boot mentality. It is difficult to forgive when you have your steel toe boot on the neck (or other body part) of your brother and sister in Christ. The next time a sermon or message moves you and cuts you to the heart, give thanks to God for keeping you on the path to righteousness.
