





CONTENDING FOR THE FAITH

"Break Up Your Fallow Ground!"

The Scriptures often use agricultural imagery to convey spiritual truths, and the concept of breaking up fallow ground is no exception. In Hosea 10:12, we find the call to action: "Sow for yourselves righteousness; reap steadfast love; break up your fallow ground, for it is the time to seek the Lord, that he may come and rain righteousness upon you."

Fallow ground refers to soil left uncultivated and unproductive. The law of Moses required the Israelites to allow their ground to be left uncultivated once every seven years (Exo. 23:11). In a spiritual context, it represents hearts and lives that have become hardened or neglected. The call to break up the fallow ground is an invitation for self-examination and renewal.

As we journey through life, it's easy for our hearts to become hardened by the challenges, disappointments, and misplaced priorities that surround us. The cares of this world can create a crust over our spiritual soil, hindering the growth of God's Word within us. However, just as a farmer tills the soil to prepare it for a bountiful harvest, similarly we called to break up the fallow ground of our hearts in order to receive the abundant blessings that God has in store for us.

Breaking up the fallow ground involves repentance, humility, and a willingness to surrender to God's power to mold us after His will.

It's a process of removing the obstacles that hinder our relationship with Him, allowing the seeds of righteousness to take root and flourish. In doing so, we position ourselves to experience the refreshing rain of God's grace and mercy. Let this be a season of spiritual cultivation in our lives. Let us seek the Lord earnestly through prayer, study of His Word, and obedience. As we break up the fallow ground within us, may our faith, love, and unity become more evident among us as a spiritual family.

Therefore, let the words of Jeremiah 4:3 resonate in our hearts: "Break up your fallow ground, and sow not among thorns." May this exhortation inspire us to prepare our hearts for the abundant blessings God desires to pour out upon us.
