





CONTENDING FOR THE FAITH

How Big is Your God?

The question "How big is your God?" is a thought-provoking one. It invites us to reflect on the nature of God and our relationship with Him. The Bible tells us that God is infinite, eternal, and unchanging. He is the Creator of the universe and everything in it. He is all-powerful, all-knowing, and ever-present. In fact, Paul, in acknowledging the power of God and our need for Him, says, "He (God), gives to all, life, breath and all things" (Acts 17:25).

Therefore, the question of "How big is your God?" is not about the physical size of God, but rather about the scope of His power and influence. It is a reminder that God is bigger than any problem we may face. He is bigger than our fears, our doubts, and our worries. He is bigger than any obstacle that may stand in our way. In response to Sarah scoffing at the idea of giving birth to a child in her

old age, the question was asked rhetorically, "Is there anything too hard for the Lord?" (Gen. 18:14).

When we consider the "size" of our God, we can only echo the question asked by David "What is man that You are mindful of him, And the son of man that You visit him?" (Psa. 8:4). Again, David was quite on point when he said about God, "For He knows our frame; He remembers that we are dust" Psa. 103:14. However, the truth is that God loves us and cares for us deeply. He knows us intimately and desires to have a personal relationship with each one of us. He is always with us, guiding us, and helping us to navigate the challenges of life (Rom. 8:31-39; Heb. 13:5).

So, the question of "How big is your God?" can only be answered sufficiently with "How deep is your faith?" Therefore, we are being challenged to trust in our all-powerful God. Prov. 3:5-6 "Trust in the LORD with all your heart and lean not on your own understanding." Let us be mindful that a lack of faith can make us use our own limitations to put similar limitations on the ability of God.
