



CONTENDING FOR THE FAITH

Greatness Is Serving

In God's Kingdom, true greatness comes from serving. Jesus Himself exemplified this truth. He declared that the last shall be first, and those who choose to be servants in this brief life will be rewarded for all eternity. The essence of greatness lies not in selfpromotion or power, but in selfless service.

What does it mean to serve? It means spending yourself—your time, talents, resources, and energy—for the good of others and the church. Jesus, the Son of Man, set the ultimate example. He didn't come to be served but to serve, even giving His life as a ransom for many. His love for humanity and His Father fueled His sacrificial service.

What does it mean to serve? It means spending yourself your time, talents, resources, and energy—for the good of others and the church.

Each Christian has received a gift/talent, unearned and by God's grace. We are, therefore, responsible to use it for the benefit of others and God's glory. Peter wrote, "Each of you should use whatever gift you have received to serve others, as faithful stewards of God's grace in its various forms" (1Pet. 4:10). However, he went on to tell them what their ultimate objective should be in the next verse, "...If anyone serves, they should do so with the strength God provides, so that in all things God may be praised through Jesus Christ. To Him be the glory and the power for ever and ever."

We must never forget that we are able to be of service because of who the source of our strength is. This is what Paul said in Phil. 4:13 "I can do all things through Christ who strengthens me." This alone should humble us as we seek to serve not just some, but every single member in the body of Christ. It is truly a reflection of the modus operandi of our Master.

Greatness, therefore, is found in serving others, especially within the church. As we follow Jesus' example, let us joyfully spend ourselves for the benefit of God's people, knowing that true greatness lies in selfless love and service.
