





CONTENDING FOR THE FAITH

The Threat of Re-Enslavement

As most countries celebrate Black History in the month of February, one can easily recall one of the most famous speeches ever given. It was on the steps of the Lincoln Memorial in Washington DC, back in 1963, that the noted civil rights leader Martin L. King Jr. delivered his "I Have a Dream" speech. It ended with the words: "...free at last, free at last, thank God, Almighty, we are free at last." His message of freedom centered on civil liberties, fairness, and justice for all, which still resonates with people on a global scale.

The value of freedom is best felt by those who were once denied it. Since we, as servants of Christ, were all slaves to unrighteousness, the experience of freedom is some-

thing to be treasured, and it gives us reasons to also rejoice that we too, are free at last. (Rom. 6:17) Paul went on to say that it is by obeying "that form of doctrine" that we gained our deliverance from sin. Our spiritual freedom involves the Lord Jesus Christ. He, Himself, taught that when the Son Let us, therefore, treasure our makes people free, they are indeed free. (John 8:36) This freedom comes when we believe in Him and obey His gospel. (8:32) In fact, only Jesus can break the chains of sin and set people free!

There is, however, an ever clear and present danger that children of God should be aware of—re-enslavement! Paul cautioned the Galatian Christians about this ever clear and present danger in Gal. 5:1 that they should "Stand fast therefore in the liberty by which Christ has made us free, and do not be entangled again with a yoke of bondage." In II Pet. 2, Peter talks about false teachers and the consequences of those who turn away from the truth "having known it," and to seduce others to follow the same. He made it clear that these men had, for a while, been freed from the pollutions of the world, but like a dog returning to its own vomit, they went right back into bondage again! They professed to be saved but had never really been redeemed (set free) at all! As a result, they were enslaved to money. (2 Peter 2:3, 14) They were slaves to covetousness resulting in them using every kind of deceptive technique to exploit innocent people. They were also in bondage to fleshly lust (2 Peter 2:10, 14) and their own pride. (2 Peter 2:10–12)

Let us, therefore, treasure our freedom in Christ by learning from the sinful deeds of these false teachers. The more we study the better we will be able to "discern both good and evil" (Heb. 5:14) so that we can know and avoid those things that will pull us back into bondage.
