





CONTENDING FOR THE FAITH

We have Passed from Death to Life

The phrase "pass from death to life" is mentioned in the Bible in 1 John 3:14. The verse reads, "We know that we have passed from death to life, because we love our brothers. The one who does not love remains in death." This verse is a reminder that the love of God is the key to eternal life. When we love others, we are showing that we have been transformed by the power of God and have passed from death to life.

This kind of love finds its origin in God as we are told in 1 John 4:7 "Beloved, let us love one another, for love is of God..." This contrasts with the hatred that Cain showed toward his brother Abel, (Gen. 4:8), which is of the world. Thankfully, we as Christians have been on the receiving end of this godly love which should naturally motivate us to love one another. 1 John 4:11 says, "Beloved, if God so loved us, we also ought to love one another."

When we truly love our brothers and sisters, we have undergone an extreme makeover by the power of God and have passed from death to life.

The Bible teaches that we all have sinned (Rom.

3:23) and consequently, are spiritually dead. However, through faith and obedience in Jesus Christ, we have been made alive and pass from death to life. This change is not something that we can achieve on our own, but it is a gift from God. When we submit our lives to Jesus as our Lord and Savior, we are given new life and are no longer bound by sin and death.

The process of passing from death to life is not a one-time event, but it is a continual process of growth and transformation. As we grow in our faith and knowledge of God, we become more like Him and are transformed into His image. This conversion is a lifelong journey that requires us to continually seek God and His will for our lives.

So, how do we know that we have passed from death to life? It is how much we genuinely love each other and show it. The apostle Peter says "Since you have purified your souls in obeying the truth through the Spirit in sincere love of the brethren," (1 Pet. 1:22). When we truly love our brothers and sisters, we have undergone an extreme makeover by the power of God and have passed from death to life.
