


WELCOME VISITING FRIENDS

Love Him Like You Know Him

Reflecting on my childhood, I remember waking up on Saturday mornings to the sounds of my parents laughing together. On Sunday mornings, as my mom sang in the shower my father could be heard cheering and edifying her as he walked around the house getting ready for church. I remember Stevie Wonder's "Knocks Me Off My Feet" coming on the radio and my parents smiling as they danced and sang together. Even if the song was playing in the car as my father drove! They would dance together to this musical testament of love. While my siblings celebrated our birthdays one day a year, my parents would spend a week celebrating each other's birthday. A week of dinners, gifts, outings, and laughter. Mother's Day and Father's Day were given equal honor in our house. This is true for salvation (Acts 8:37) and also for our daily lives. Our love can't be restrained to Sunday morning worship. Like Major Harris our love won't let us wait until Sunday to give God praise but our daily lives must be a living testament of our love for God. His love for us is made plain for all to see (John 3:16; Matthew 6:26-32). Won't He do it? Didn't He do it? Ain't He doing it?

Let's open our mouths, open our hearts and show God some love!
