



## **CONTENDING FOR THE FAITH**

### **Are We Ready for Worship?**

Worship is more than a routine—it's an encounter with the Living God. As we step into worship, we should come with hearts expectant and ready to meet Him. Let's investigate what it means to be prepared for worship.

We must come with prepared hearts. Our hearts can easily become cluttered with worries, distractions, and sin. We must take time, before worship, to examine our hearts. A prepared heart is receptive to His presence. "Create in me a clean heart, O God, and renew a right spirit within me." (Psalm 51:10). Are we filled with anticipation? This is something that we should really pray about. David said, in Psa. 122:1, "I was glad when they said unto me, Let us go into the house of the Lord." When we reflect on what God has done for us and how He sacrificed His Son to procure our salvation, we should be energized to worship Him. In fact, David felt so indebted to God that he asked "What shall I give back to God for all His benefits towards me?" Psa. 116:12.

We must be ready to engage with scriptures. The psalmist says, "Your word is a "What shall I give back to lamp for my feet, a light on my path." (Psalm 119:105) God's Word is central to worship. Read and meditate on Scripture throughout the towards me?" week. When the Word is proclaimed during the Psa. 116:12. service, listen attentively. Let it guide your thoughts, prayers, and responses. God for all His benefits

**Purpose.** Singing is a powerful way to express our praise. Engage wholeheartedly in worship songs. Whether you have a beautiful voice or not, God delights in your worship. Sing with purpose, knowing that your praises reach His throne. "Sing to the Lord a new song; sing to the Lord, all the earth." (Psalm 96:1). We should expect God's presence. Believe that God is present when His people gather. He communes with us when we partake in the Lord's Supper (Matt. 26-28-29). Worship is not a performance; it is an encounter with the Almighty. "For where two or three are gather in my name, there am I with them." (Matthew 18:20)

So, as we prepare for worship, let's remember that God desires our hearts more than our rituals. Let's come ready to meet Him, knowing that He eagerly awaits our worship. May we encounter the living God and leave changed.
