




# WELCOME VISITING FRIENDS

# **CONTENDING FOR THE FAITH**

# **Stand Firm!**

Living for Christ will inevitably come with its challenges and adversities. Yet, amidst the trials, the call to stand firm in our faith could not be more relevant. The phrase "Stand Firm" captures the essence of the Christian's unwavering commitment to serve God, no matter the circumstances.

Throughout Scripture, we find numerous examples of steadfast faith. One such instance is the story of Shadrach, Meshach, and Abednego in Daniel 3. Faced with the fiery furnace, they declared their unwavering trust in God, saying, "If we are thrown into the blazing furnace, the God we serve is able to deliver us from it... But even if He does not, we want you to know, Your Majesty, that we will not serve your gods or worship the image of gold you have set up" (Daniel 3:17-18). Their refusal to retreat or surrender in the face of imminent danger is a powerful testament of their faith.

Similarly, the apostle Paul, despite numerous persecutions, hardships, and imprisonments, never wavered in his mission to spread the Gospel. In 2 Cor. 4:8-9, Paul writes, "We are hard pressed on every side, but not crushed; perplexed, but not in despair; persecuted, but not abandoned; struck down, but not destroyed." His resilience and determination still serve as a profound encouragement to us all.

Standing firm means anchoring ourselves in God's promises, trusting in His sovereignty, and relying on His strength. It means not compromising our faith, even when the world pressures us to do so.

As children of God, today, we may not face literal furnaces or physical imprisonments, but we do encounter spiritual battles, societal pressures, and personal struggles. In these moments, the call to "stand firm" resonates deeply. Ephesians 6:13-14 urges us to "put on the full armor of God, so that when the day of evil comes, you may be able to stand your ground, and after you have done everything, to stand. Stand firm then..."

Standing firm means anchoring ourselves in God's promises, trusting in His sovereignty, and relying on His strength. It means not compromising our faith, even when the world pressures us to do so.

Let us, therefore, embrace this call with courage and conviction. Let us face our challenges head -on, knowing that with God by our side, we can stand firm. We must stand firm – for we are more than conquerors through Him who loved us (Romans 8:37).
