### **CONTENDING FOR THE FAITH**

### **Interesting Sayings in Hosea**

I have given some attention to what I think are interesting sayings in Jeremiah and Isaiah. Today I would like to give some attention to some sayings in Hosea that I think are interesting. Probably the best-known passage in this Book of the Bible is found in Hosea 4:6. My people are destroyed for lack of knowledge: because thou hast rejected knowledge, I will also reject thee, that thou shalt be no priest to me: seeing thou hast forgotten the law of thy God, I also will forget thy children (ASV).

The passage doesn't need much explanation because it's readily understood as one reads it. It may not need much attention, but any devoted student of Scripture can't fail to note that, in fact, it needs much attention. It has often been said that those who refuse to learn from history are doomed to repeat it. This means that if we fail to learn from the experiences of those who lived before us, we fall into the same traps they did because we are doing the same as they did. Peter made it very clear that while he lived, he was going to remind the brethren to pay attention to those things that are of God, and by doing this we can avoid snares that spring up from everywhere (2 Peter 1:3-15).

How can anyone be destroyed by lack of knowledge? Knowledge is instruction in a specific How can anyone be area that is supposed to benefit the recipient. From the Lord He imparted to us His Word whereby we can learn the ways of God and travel the path of Jesus. If one does not learn from God, upon what path will he travel? Later, the Lord, through Ho-

sea, gave a stern rebuke to the people of Israel because they refused to learn from Him. For they sow the wind, and they shall reap the whirlwind: he hath no standing grain; the blade shall yield no meal; if so, be it yield, strangers shall swallow it up (8:7). To sow the wind is to sow emptiness, it is to so seed that has its origin in man and to have the wind blow it wherever it will. In Hosea 10:13, the Lord said this is what they did, You have plowed iniquity; you have reaped injustice; you have eaten the fruit of lies. Because you have trusted in your own way and in the multitude of your warriors (ESV).

Are any of us guilty of something similar? We may be more than we think! When one sows the wisdom / thinking of man, he's not sure what he has sown because the quaint expression today may not have the same impact tomorrow. With the Lord, however, the bedrock of His thinking is sure (firm) when man lives in a sea of doubt. Instead of sowing emptiness, let us be reminded that we need to Sow to yourselves in righteousness, reap according to kindness; break up vour fallow ground; for it is time to seek Jehovah, till he come and rain righteousness upon you (10:12).
