

CONTENDING FOR THE FAITH

Don't Stop 'Til You Get Enough!

As a biology teacher, I teach my students that one main requirement for living things is the consumption of materials for growth, development and sustenance. Plants must consume water and various nutrients in the soil. Bacteria utilize water and organic materials (be it on a dead organism or the dusty surface of a lightbulb). Christians, in order to grow, develop, and be sustained must consume righteousness. Jesus tells us in Matthew 5:6 that those who "hunger and thirst for righteousness" will be filled. Jesus further states that He is the Bread of life and those who ingest or take in his teachings will be filled (John 6:47-55). With this in mind, how can we, as Christians, refuse to eat? How can we turn down spiritual food?

An unfortunate question that is often asked by Christians is "How much is enough?". evening worship service?" or "Do I have to attend Bible class?" are nothing more than declarations that "I have had enough spir-Matthew 5:6 says that we should hunger and thirst for righteousness, not turn it down when offered. Hebrews 10:23-25 encourages us to hold on to our faith (v. 23),

Hebrews 10:25 warns us against Such questions as, "Do I have to attend forsaking the assembling--any time the saints come together. This includes evening service, itual food", "I have had enough Jesus!". bible classes, gospel meetings, prayer meetings, or any gathering of the saints.

to provoke one another to do good (v. 24), and to not forsake the assembling of the saints (v. 25). Verses 23 and 24 are readily accepted, but once we get to verse 25, we begin to frown. We say things like, "it doesn't say Bible class" or "it doesn't say evening service". We are right, it doesn't say those things verbatim. However, Hebrews 10:25 warns us against forsaking the assembling--any time the saints come together. This includes evening service, bible classes, gospel meetings, prayer meetings, or any gathering of the saints. The Hebrew writer goes as far as to say that we should come together more frequently, as Judgement Day approaches. Why? To help us hold fast to our faith (Hebrews 10:25), to maintain the unity of the church (Ephesians 4: 3; 1 Corinthians 1:10), and so that we may be filled with the righteous teachings of Christ (Matthew 5:6; John 6:47-55). To continue to be filled, we must continue to be hungry for righteousness!

Therefore, my response to the question of "how often do we have to come together?" is echoed the immortal words of Michael Jackson: "Don't stop 'til you get enough".
