## **CONTENDING FOR THE FAITH**

## I Am an Unprofitable Servant?

In Luke 17:10, Jesus says, "So you also, when you have done everything you were told to do, should say, 'We are unprofitable servants; we have only done our duty." This statement can be perplexing, but it holds profound truths about our relationship with God and our role as His servants. When Jesus refers to us as "unprofitable servants," He does not mean that our service is worthless. Instead, He emphasizes that our good works do not earn us merit or favor with God. Our salvation and standing before God are based solely on His grace, not on our deeds. This concept counters on the idea that we can earn God's favor through our actions. As Ephesians 2:8-9 reminds us, "For it is by grace you have been saved, through faith—and this is not from yourselves, it is the gift of God—not by works, so that no one can boast."

A servant's duty is to obey the master's commands without expecting special recognition or reward. In the same way, our obedience to God is simply fulfilling our duty as His creation. We are called to serve God out of love and grati-

tude for what He has done for us, not to gain His approval. This perspective shifts our focus from seeking personal glory to glorifying God in all we do. It reminds us that our best efforts are still insufficient to earn salvation (Isa. 64:6). This truth should inspire us to serve God with a pure heart, motivated by love rather than obligation.

Let us, therefore, remember that any good we do is by God's grace. This humility prevents pride and fosters a spirit of gratitude, while at the same time we commit to obeying God's commands, knowing that our service is our duty and privilege as His children. May we extend grace to others, understanding that we all rely on God's mercy. This grace should be evident in our interactions and relationships. As unprofitable servants, we acknowledge that our worth comes from God's grace, not our works. This understanding frees us from striving for approval and allows us to serve God with joy and gratitude. Let us embrace our role as humble servants, faithfully doing our duty and trusting in God's abundant grace.
