CONTENDING FOR THE FAITH

The Art of Standing Still

I have fond memories as a child playing freeze tag. If you have never played, a player who is "it" chases other players in an attempt to tag them. Once touched by the "it" player, the individual must stop moving, in effect frozen in whatever position they were in when touched. More recently, there was a "Mannequin Challenge" on TikTok where people stood completely still, often in outrageous positions. This challenge and freeze tag were challenging because it requires participants to stand still.

How often do we find ourselves praying for God to bless us, but when we

feel He is moving too slowly we take matters into our own hands? We pray to God for wisdom, but when we feel like his word isn't doing it for us, we turn to other books, other people, even other beliefs. We don't stand still long enough to realize that God is working. In Exodus 14:13-14, we find

the children of Israel frantic and afraid. They question why Moses brought them out of bondage and into bewilderment. Moses tells them in verse 13, "Do not be afraid, stand still" (NKJV). In verse 14, Moses says, "The LORD shall fight for you; you need only to be still" (NIV). As Moses speaks to the children of Israel, he also speaks to us. We must, with our whole heart, trust God and believe that he is on our side (Proverbs 3:5; Psalm 124:1). This trust may require us to stand still, no matter the discomfort. The influences of the world will have us to act now and apologize later, but that is not the life we are called to live. Let us continue to step only when and where we are ordered (Psalm 27:23). Let our steps be preceded with prayer (Philippians 4:6).

We live in a world that tells us, "Don't just stand there, do something!", but God often tells us, "Don't just do something, stand there!". For it is in our stillness that we begin to witness the movement and wonder of God.
