
WELCOME VISITING FRIENDS

CONTENDING FOR THE FAITH

A Friend of God

There is a word that has such a sweet sound to everyone who hears it. It's the word "friend." Is that not just a most beautiful word? It's a word that brings a smile to the face of everyone who hears it. Friendship is something that we crave, like food and water. We seek it out. When we move into a new town or start a new job, what is the first thing we begin to look for? We are looking for friends. We do this because friends are so meaningful to us. Some friends are just as close as blood relatives. "A man who has friends must himself be friendly, but there is a friend who sticks closer than a brother." (Prov. 18:24)


Though there are many other things we could say about friends, consider the following passage with me. "And the Scripture was fulfilled which savs, "Abraham believed God, and it was accounted to him for righteousness." And he was called the friend of God." (Jam. 2:23) Notice that Abraham is identified as "the friend of God." This is not the only time in the scriptures where this statement is made. "But you, Israel, are My

servant, Jacob whom I have chosen, The descendants of Abraham My friend." (Isa. 41:8) "Are You not our God, who drove out the inhabitants of this land before Your people Israel, and gave it to the descendants of Abraham Your friend forever?" (2 Chron. 20:7) What a compliment! When God thought of Abraham, He not only thought of him as His friend but His friend forever. What caused Abraham to be the friend of God? He was obedient to the Lord in the life he lived. "By faith Abraham obeyed when he was called to go out to the place which he would receive as an inheritance. And he went out, not knowing where he was going." (Heb. 11:8) "By faith Abraham, when he was tested, offered up Isaac, and he who had received the promises offered up his only begotten son, of whom it was said, "In Isaac your seed shall be called," concluding that God was able to raise him up, even from the dead, from which he also received him in a figurative sense," (vs. 17-19) Because of his continual life of obedience, he was recognized as the forever friend of God.

What about you? Does God think of you as His friend? Do you live every day knowing that God is always going to be your friend? God wants to be our friend just as He was the friend of Abraham. What does it take to be a friend of God? Listen to the scriptures. "You are My friends if you do whatever I command you." (Jn. 14:15) In other words, it takes obedience. Was that not true of Abraham? He lived a life of obedience and as a result, he was the friend of God. When we live a life of obedience, striving to keep the commandments of the Lord, we too can live every day with the constant assurance that we are friends with God.
