CONTENDING FOR THE FAITH

God's Not in a Hurry, You Are!

In our fast-paced world, it's easy to feel like life is a race against time. Deadlines, appointments, and endless to-do lists leave us constantly in a rush. We often carry this urgency into our spiritual lives, expecting God to operate on our timeline. Yet, the truth is, God's not in a hurry—we are. And, understanding His timing can radically change our perspective. The Bible is filled with stories that demonstrate God's perfect timing. Take Abraham and Sarah, who waited decades for the promised son, Isaac. Or consider Joseph, who endured years of slavery and imprisonment before stepping into his God-ordained role as Egypt's leader. Even Jesus, during His earthly ministry, modeled patience and trust in the Father's timing, saying, "My hour has not yet come" (John 2:4).

Why does God make us wait? One reason is He's weaving that waiting refines us. When we're forced to slow down, we have the opportunity to develop trust, patience, and character. Isaiah 40:31 reminds us that those who wait on the Lord **not yet understand.** will renew their strength, soar on wings like

eagles, and run without growing weary. Waiting isn't a waste of time; it's preparation. God uses delays to shape us into the people He created us to be. Another reason God doesn't rush, is that His plans are always bigger than ours. We often want immediate solutions to our problems, but God sees the bigger picture. He's weaving a masterpiece, and each delay serves a purpose we may not yet understand. As Proverbs 16:9 says, "In their hearts humans plan their course, but the Lord establishes their steps." His timing is not only perfect; it's purposeful.

So, what can we do while we wait? First, surrender our timeline to God and trust in His sovereignty. Second, use the waiting season to deepen our relationship with God through prayer and Scripture. Finally, embrace the present moment. Often, we're so focused on the destination that we miss what God is doing in the here and now. Remember, God is never late. His timing is deliberate, designed for His glory and your good. The next time you feel rushed, take a deep breath and remind yourself: God's not in a hurry—you are. Trust Him, and you'll find peace in the wait.
