Yet, I saw a neighbor a few days ago getting his snowblower tuned up, another covering his a/c unit, and another getting his heating system either repaired or tuned, upon observing the Heating company vehicle parked in his driveway.

The Bible encourages us to be prepared in various aspects of our faith. In 2 Timothy 4:2, Paul exhorts Timothy, "Preach the word; be prepared in season and out of season; correct, rebuke and encourage—with great patience and careful instruction." This verse highlights the importance of being ready to share the gospel and minister to others at all times.

1 Peter 3:15 further emphasizes readiness: "But sancti- Are you prepared to trust fy the Lord God in your hearts, and always be ready to give a defense to everyone who asks you a reason for the hope that is in you, with meekness and fear;" As Christians, our readiness extends to defending our faith and sharing the hope we have in Jesus, doing so with **your own?** humility and love.

So, what are you ready for? Are you prepared to trust God's timing and plans, even when they differ from your own? In Proverbs 3:5-6, we are reminded to, "Trust in the Lord with all your heart and lean not on your own understanding; in all your ways submit to him, and he will make your paths straight." Readiness also means being equipped to face trials and challenges. Ephesians 6:10-11 states: "Finally, my brethren, be strong in the Lord and in the power of His might. Put on the whole armor of God, that you may be able to stand against the wiles of the devil." Spiritual readiness involves arming ourselves with faith, truth, righteousness, and the word of God in order to withstand spiritual battles.

Therefore, the question "What are you ready for?" is a call to introspection and action. It challenges us to examine our faith, our trust in God, and our willingness to step into His plans with courage and preparedness. Let us continually seek to be ready, not only for the blessings but also for the challenges that come our way, knowing that God equips and strengthens us for every good work.
