CONTENDING FOR THE FAITH

The Battle Belongs to the Lord

In 1 Samuel 17:47, we read the powerful words spoken by young David: "All those gathered here will know that it is not by sword or spear that the Lord saves; for the battle is the Lord's, and He will give all of you into our hands." This declaration, made in the face of the giant Goliath, captures a profound truth about the nature of God's sovereignty and the power of faith.
