Set Apart for the Gospel

Galatians 1:15-16 "But when it pleased God, who separated me from my mother's womb and called me through His grace, to reveal His Son to me, that I might preach Him among the Gentiles, I did not immediately confer with flesh and blood..."

In his letter to the churches in Galatia, Paul di- We are chosen by God, not to rects their minds to the powerful truth of being set apart for the gospel. In Galatians 1:15, the live for ourselves, but to serve Apostle Paul shares his testimony of how God Him and proclaim His gospel. uniquely called him, even before his birth, to fulfill a divine purpose. This calling was not based on Paul's merit but on God's grace. Like Paul each of us has been set apart by God for a specif-

ic purpose—to live for His glory and share the good news of Jesus Christ. This message is conveyed by Paul a few verses later when he declared "I have been crucified with Christ; it is no longer I who live, but Christ lives in me; and the life which I now live in the flesh I live by faith in the Son of God, who loved me and gave Himself for me" (Gal. 2:20).

Being set apart means recognizing that our lives are not our own. In 1 Cor. 6:19-20 Paul says, "Or do you not know that your body is the temple of the Holy Spirit who is in you, whom you have from God, and you are not your own? For you were bought at a price; therefore glorify God in your body and in your spirit, which are God's." Paul's question to the Lord on the road to Damascus, tells us how willing he was in dedicating his life for the cause of his Savior, Jesus Christ in Acts 9:6 "So he, trembling and astonished, said, "Lord, what do You want me to do?" Then the Lord said to him, "Arise and go into the city, and you will be told what you must do." We are chosen by God, not to live for ourselves, but to serve Him and proclaim His gospel. This calling is not reserved for preachers, elders or deacons alone; it is for every Christian. Whether in our homes, workplaces, or communities, we are called to reflect Christ's love and truth.

So, let us ask ourselves: Am I living out the purpose God has for me? God's grace empowers us to fulfill this calling, just as it empowered Paul. We may face challenges, doubts, or even opposition, but we can trust that God, who sets us apart, will equip us for every task He assigns. Let us also remember that being set apart is not about isolation but about transformation. It is about being in the world but not of the world (John 17:14-16), shining as lights in the darkness.
