CONTENDING FOR THE FAITH

Shining as Lights

Philippians 2:15 "that you may become blameless and harmless, children of God without fault in the midst of a crooked and perverse generation, among whom you shine as lights in the world..."

The fact that Paul wrote this letter to the Philippians from behind bars makes his call for us to be beacons of hope, shining brightly with the light of Christ, even more significant. He told them in Phil 2:15, that they were to be "blameless and harmless, the children of God, without fault." This is not an easy thing to do considering that the world around us is often "crooked and perverse," filled with confusion, negativity, and a departure from God's truth. Yet, amid this darkness, we are not to yield to the world's attractions. Instead, just as light differentiates itself from darkness, we are to rise and "shine as lights in the world."

What does it mean to shine as lights? It means demonstrating the love, grace, and truth of Jesus Christ in our daily lives. It means living with integrity, showing compassion to those in need, and speaking words of encouragement and hope. It means being a living sacrifice through the help of my community? the Holy Spirit. this light; it is the light of Christ which is reflected through us. Just as a lamp needs a power source to shine, we need to remain connected to Jesus, the true Light of the world (John 8:12). Through prayer, Bible study, and fellowship, our relationship with Him is nurtured, allowing His light to shine brightly through us.

Our society often celebrates self-centeredness and selfishness, hence, our light as Christians, should be a powerful difference-maker. A kind word, a helping hand, a forgiving heart – these small acts of love can make a significant impact, drawing others to the source of true light. This is exactly what Christ is saying in Matt. 5:16 "Let your light so shine before men, that they may see your good works and glorify your Father in heaven."

Let us ask ourselves: Where can I shine brighter? How can I be a more effective light in my family, my church family, my workplace, my community? Let us strive to live lives that glorify God, reflecting His love and truth to a world desperately in need of hope.

May we, as a family of Christians, embrace our calling to be lights in the world. Let us shine brightly, dispelling the darkness and drawing others into the marvelous light of Jesus Christ.
