CONTENDING FOR THE FAITH

Unprofitable Servants We Are!

We all appreciate accolades and praise, and while there is nothing inherently wrong with them, the danger lies in what they can produce: pride and arrogance in our own abilities and wisdom. Therefore, we are instructed to do everything for the glory of God, as stated in Ephesians 2:8-9: "For by grace you have been saved through faith, and that not of yourselves; it is the gift of God, not of works, lest anyone should boast."

The early disciples understood their role as servants of Christ and were relentless in their work. In fact, Hebrews 6:10 tells us that the Lord takes note of our "labor of love." There is much to be done in the Lord's church, and like Isaiah, we must say, "Here I am, send me" (Isaiah 6:8). Today, the church stands on the shoulders of those who have worked tirelessly for God. For the church to continue impacting lives, we at West Hammond must see ourselves as humble servants, honored and privileged to work in this divine institution.

Instead of striving for "bonus points" from our Lord for our work in the church, we need to remember that, according to Luke 17:10, we are "but unprofitable servants," merely fulfilling our required duties. Everything we possess and all that we accomplish stem from God's grace. Our abilities, opportunities, and even our desire to serve are gifts from Him. Therefore, any good we achieve is fundamentally a reflection of His goodness working through us. Even when we diligently follow God's commands and labor in His service, we should neither boast nor feel entitled to praise; we are simply fulfilling our duty as those blessed by Him. Our motivation for serving God should not be based on the expectation of earthly rewards or recognition. We serve because we love Him and desire to participate in His work in the world (Col. 3:23).

Luke 17:10 is not intended to discourage us; rather, it grounds us in a proper perspective. It frees us from the burden of seeking human validation (John 12:42-43), and directs our focus toward pleasing God. When we approach service with this understanding, it nurtures a spirit of gratitude, dependence on God, and a genuine desire to honor Him in all we do. It serves as a reminder that we are stewards of what God has given us, and our greatest joy should come from faithfully using those gifts for His glory, without expecting personal gain or accolades. We are simply doing what we have been called to do.
