CONTENDING FOR THE FAITH

Learning to Lean on Each Other

The annual Jamaican Boys and Girls High School Track and Field Championships are regarded as the best in the world due to the high level of competitive performance, support, and enthusiasm it generates. These championships also produce world-class athletes such as Usain Bolt, Shelly-Ann Fraser-Pryce and others. The organizers deliberately schedule the relay events last because of the excitement it produces, showcasing how each team member depends on the other to get the baton safely around the track to the finish line.

The concept of collaboration is contrary to today's culture that often glorifies individualism. However, this principle aligns with biblical teachings as designed by Christ for His church. The New Testament emphasizes this truth repeatedly; Hebrews 10:24-25 urges believers, "And let us consider one another in order to stir up love and good works, not forsaking the assembling of ourselves together, as is the manner of some, but exhorting one another, and so much the more as you see the Day approaching. Gathering together is a spiritual necessity rather than a



mere tradition. When individuals isolate themselves, they become vulnerable to discouragement, temptation, and weakened faith. Conversely, unity fosters strength, accountability, and encouragement. The early church exemplified this interdependence beautifully. Acts 2:44-46 describes how members "...were together, and had all things in common, and sold their possessions and goods, and divided them among all, as anyone had need. So continuing daily with one accord in the temple, and breaking bread from house to house, they ate their food with gladness and simplicity of heart." Their unity was not superficial—it was a vital lifeline of reciprocal encouragement, shared resources, and collective purpose. Even the apostle Paul, known for his bold and independent missionary work, relied on the support of fellow Christians. He wrote to the Romans, "For I long to see you, that I may impart to you some spiritual gift, so that you may be established—that is, that I may be encouraged together with you by the mutual faith both of you and me" (Rom. 1:11-12). If Paul yearned for the support of others, how much more do we?

Christ designed the church in which members learn to lean on each other for support (1 Cor. 12:12-27). A hand cannot function without the arm, and an eye is useless without the body. Similarly, we need each other's words of encouragement, prayers, and presence. Whether in times of joy or hardship, we are called to "bear each other's burdens" (Gal. 6:2).

Let us therefore reject the fallacy of self-sufficiency and embrace the beauty of learning to lean on each other.
