CONTENDING FOR THE FAITH

Our Mothers in the Church

Mothers hold a unique and God-ordained role within the family, and their presence in the church is nothing short of a divine blessing. From teaching Bible stories to children, to praying faithfully over their homes and walking in godly wisdom, mothers bring grace, nurture, and spiritual strength into the church family.

The Bible is filled with examples of godly mothers who served as instruments of God's will. One prominent example is Hannah, the mother of the prophet Samuel. In 1 Samuel 1:27-28, she says, "I asked the Lord to give me this boy, and he has granted my request. Now I am giving him to the Lord, and he will belong to the Lord his whole life." And they worshiped the Lord there" (NLT). Hannah's dedication not only shaped Samuel's life but also impacted the spiritual direction of Israel. Her faith and obedience remind us that mothers nurture not just children, but future generations of leaders. In the New Testament, we see the influence of Lois and Eunice, the grandmother and mother of Timothy. Paul wrote in 2 Timothy 1:5, "when I



call to remembrance the genuine faith that is in you, which dwelt first in your grandmother Lois and your mother Eunice, and I am persuaded is in you also." The spiritual mentorship of these women helped shape Timothy into a strong leader in the early church. This legacy affirms the vital contribution of mothers who instill faith and courage in their children. Mothers in the church serve not only within their own households but also often step into roles such as teachers, counselors, and mentors. Proverbs 31:26 says, "She speaks with wisdom, and faithful instruction is on her tongue." Through their words and actions, mothers provide care and guidance that uphold the body of Christ.

Additionally, their endurance and sacrificial love reflect the very heart of the gospel. Just as Jesus laid down his life for others, mothers often abandon their own comfort for the well-being of their families and the church. Isaiah 66:13 captures this nurturing essence: "I will comfort you there in Jerusalem as a mother comforts her child" (NLT). This maternal image helps us understand aspects of God's character.

Our mothers here at West Hammond Church of Christ, play an integral role in the spiritual and emotional health of the church. Their faithfulness, prayer lives, and sacrificial service symbolize Christlike love, which will continue to inspire future mothers. Let us honor, support, and celebrate the women whom God has called to motherhood, both in the home and in the house of God.
