CONTENDING FOR THE FAITH

You Are Worth More Than You Think!

In a world that constantly measures worth by achievements, possessions, or social approval, it's easy to feel inadequate. You might compare yourself to others and wonder, Do I matter? Am I enough? But here's the truth: You are worth far more than you think!

The world doesn't determine your value. Society often tells us our worth is tied to our success, appearance, or productivity. But God's perspective is entirely different. Scripture says, "Are not five sparrows sold for two pennies? Yet not one of them is forgotten by God. Indeed, the very hairs of your head are all numbered. Don't be afraid; you are worth more than many sparrows" (Luke 12:6-7). If God cares for something as small as a sparrow, how much more does He value you? It then should



come as no surprise to learn that "... God so love the world that He gave His only begotten Son that whoever believes in Him should not perish but have everlasting life" (John 3:16). This is not speaking of the things of this world but the people who inhabit it, they are the ones that God's Son died for. That is the strongest affirmation of our worth! God desires that all men be saved from the consequences of their sins, as the apostle Peter informs us in 1 Timothy. 2:3-4 "For this is good and acceptable in the sight of God our Savior, who desires all men to be saved and to come to the knowledge of the truth.

Our worth and value increase indescribably when we are baptized into Christ. Peter now calls us "... a chosen generation, a royal priesthood, a holy nation, His own special people, that you may proclaim the praises of Him who called you out of darkness into His marvelous light; who once were not a people but are now the people of God, who had not obtained mercy but now have obtained mercy" (1 Pet. 2:9-10). John later tells us that "and from Jesus Christ, the faithful witness, the firstborn from the dead, and the ruler over the kings of the earth. To Him who loved us and washed us from our sins in His own blood and has made us kings and priests to His God and Father, to Him be glory and dominion forever and ever. Amen." (Rev. 1:5-6).

Thankfully, our worth is determined by our Lord, who has made us worthy through obedience to His gospel.
